Once you have been approved to sit for the ABCN Written Examination, you are responsible for scheduling an appointment to take the examination.

INTERNET SCHEDULING

Once you have been approved by the American Board of Clinical Neuropsychology (ABCN), you will receive an email confirmation from PSI. You are responsible for contacting PSI to schedule the examination. Your eligibility is valid for one examination attempt.

For the fastest and most convenient test scheduling process, PSI recommends that candidates schedule their exams using the Internet. Candidates schedule online by accessing PSI's scheduling website at www.psiexams.com or by clicking the link provided in the initial email received from PSI. Internet scheduling is available 24 hours-a-day. In order to register by Internet, complete the steps below:

1. Log on to PSI's website and create an account (it is easiest to click on the link embedded in the registration confirmation email you received from PSI). Please enter your email address and name. This information must match exactly with the information you previously submitted to the ABCN. Be sure to check the box next to "Check here to attempt to locate existing records for you in the system."
2. Create your password, select your security question, and create your security answer.
3. Once you are logged in, your record will be found and you will now be ready to pay for and schedule the exam.

Note that the fee charged by PSI is NOT included in the examination fee paid to ABPP/ABCN.

4. Enter your zip code and a list of the testing sites closest to you will appear. Once you select the desired testing site, available dates will appear.

CANCELING AN EXAMINATION APPOINTMENT

You may cancel and reschedule an examination appointment without forfeiting your fee if your *cancellation notice is received 48 hours before the scheduled examination date. If you do not cancel within 48 hours of your scheduled session or if you are absent for test, you will forfeit your exam fee.* If you meet the cancellation requirements and do not test, you are eligible to request a refund. To do so, please contact PSI Customer Service no later than 30 days after the close of the testing window.

Note: A voicemail or email message is not an acceptable form of cancellation. Please use the telephone system to speak directly to a Customer Service Representative.

MISSED APPOINTMENT OR LATE CANCELLATION

Your registration will be invalid, you will not be able to take the examination as scheduled, and you will forfeit your PSI fee, if you:

- Do not cancel your appointment at least 48 hours before the scheduled examination date;
- Do not appear for your examination appointment;
- Arrive after examination start time;
- Do not present proper identification when you arrive for the examination;
- **Your ABPP registration fee is not affected by canceling, rescheduling, or missing an examination appointment at PSI.**

EXAM ACCOMMODATIONS

All examination centers are equipped to provide access in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, and every reasonable accommodation will be made in meeting a candidate's needs. Applicants with disabilities or those who would otherwise have difficulty taking the examination must get pre-approved by the American Board of Clinical Neuropsychology.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION AT THE EXAMINATION SITE

Candidates need to provide one (1) valid form of non-expired, government issued identification, bearing photo and signature.

Candidates must register for the exam with their LEGAL first and last name as it appears on their government issued identification. All required identification below must match the first and last name under which the candidate is registered.

ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION - Choose One (Must be current)

- State or Canadian provincial or territorial issued driver's license
- State or Canadian provincial or territorial issued identification card
- US or Canadian Government Issued Military Identification Card
- US Government Issued Alien Registration Card
- Any Government Issued Passport
- Any Government Issued ID

Failure to provide one of the required identifications at the time of the examination without notifying PSI is considered a missed appointment and you will not be able to take the examination at that time.

SECURITY PROCEDURES

The following security procedures will apply during the examination:

PSI proctor-issued scratch paper and pencil OR dry-erase board and markers are allowed.

- While at an examination site, you are considered to be a professional and shall be treated as such. In turn, you must conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times. While at the site, you shall not use words or take actions that are vulgar, obscene, libelous, or that would denigrate the staff or other candidates.
- NO conversing or any other form of communication among candidates is permitted once you enter the examination area.
- Cell phones, pagers, and children are not allowed in the examination center. **NO personal items are to enter the testing center.** Candidates are encouraged to leave all personal belongings except their keys in their car.
- No smoking, eating, or drinking will be allowed at the examination site.
- Copying or communicating examination content is a violation of security policy. Either one may result in the disqualification of examination results and may lead to legal action.

TESTING SITES

There are examination centers across the United States and Canada. You will be provided with the locations upon scheduling for your examination.

EXAMINATION RESULTS

Candidates will receive participation notice after completion of the exam. Exam results will typically be provided to you by ABCN, within 4 weeks of the close of the testing window.
